On Monday, August 24th, the director of athletics from all seven PECSAA schools met virtually via Zoom to work out a plan for all our programs to "Return To Play." The health and safety of our student athletes and their families have been the forefront of all discussions and will continue to be as we maneuver through this action.

The following season sports schedules were discussed and unanimously approved by all seven PECSAA athletic directors:

❖ Fall

- Start Date: November 4, 2020 - tryouts and practices may begin for the following sports:
 - Cross Country - limited to 1 contest per week
 - Soccer (boys or co-ed) - limited to 1 contest per week
- End Date: December 11, 2020

❖ Winter

- Start Date: December 7, 2020 - tryouts and practices may begin for the following sports:
 - Basketball - limited to 2 contests per week; Contests beginning January 4, 2020
- End Date: February 26, 2020

❖ Spring 1

- Start Date: March 1, 2020 - tryouts and practices may begin for the following sports:
 - Volleyball - limited to 2 contests per week
 - Golf - limited to 1 contest per week
- End Date: April 30, 2020

❖ Spring 2

- Start Date: April 12, 2020 - tryouts and practices may begin for the following sports:
 - Track - limited to 1 contests per week
 - Girls Soccer (if your school offers this program) - limited to 2 contests per week
- End Date: May 28, 2020
